

Internships in Japan Programme 2012-13

From the next academic year, MA students will be offered an opportunity to do internships in Japan. Our partners include museums, governmental offices and research institutes. **The internship will last 2-3 months and will be financed by the Faculty of Humanities of Leiden University.** The internship is a part of the Japanese track of the one-year MA program featuring two specializations: “East Asian Studies” and “History, Arts and Culture of Asia”. It will function as one of the elective courses **(10 ETC)**. Prospective candidates will be selected by a specially appointed committee. The selection will be based on the candidates’ study records, their commitment to specific area of study and certified Japanese language abilities.

Details:

1. Time frame

The internship will begin in April and will last 2-3 months.

2. Financing

Student’s transportation to/from Japan and accommodation will be covered by the Faculty of Humanities of Leiden University.

3. Intern duties

Working hours should not exceed 20 hours per week divided in 3-4 days. The tasks will be decided by the partner-institutions in consultation with the Leiden University.

4. Application and assessment

Students interested in taking part in the Programme are asked to submit the Research Plan Proposal describing their research projects. After concluding the internship the students will submit the Internship Final Reports. The students will be graded on the basis of the Reports and the partner-institution assessments.
